







TWO PART FOAM (Foam Expander Plug)

Health, Safety and Environmental Assessment

SAFETY FIRST

	<u>Head Protection</u> Use a hard hat.
	<u>Hand Protection</u> Use protective gloves mad of rubber, neoprene or PVC.
	<u>Eye Protection</u> Use approved chemical safety goggles.
	<u>Nose & Mouth Protection</u> Normal dusk mask is needed.
	<u>Safety Overall</u> Wear appropriate clothing to prevent any possibility of liquid contact
	<u>Safety Boots</u> Wear appropriate shoes.

First Aid Measures

GENERAL: Soiled, soaked clothing and shoes must be immediately removed, decontaminated and disposed of.

SKIN CONTACT: After contact with skin, preferably wash a cleanser based on polyethylene glycol or with plenty of warm water and soap. Consult a doctor in the event of skin reaction.

INHALATION: If aerosol or vapour is inhaled in high concentrations; Take the person into fresh air and keep him warm, let him rest; if there is difficulty in breathing, medical advice is required

EYE CONTACT: Hold the eyes open and rinse with preferably lukewarm water for sufficiently long period of time (at least 10 minutes). Contact a doctor (or eye specialist) immediately.

SWALLOWING: Should the product be swallowed seek medical advice. DO NOT induce the patient to vomit.

BE AWARE, BE SAFE

- ⚠ Do not expose foam to open flames or sparks
- ⚠ Store out of direct sunlight
- ⚠ Do not puncture the bags



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PLEASE HANDLE WITH CARE

NB! NOT TO DO

- Do not throw the boxes – handle with care.
- Do not puncture the foam bags.
- Do not put the bag on an open fire.
- Do not eat, drink or sniff the product – it may cause irritation.
